Our windows acknowledge the uniqueness of Huapai and Kumeu areas with its place amongst orchards, farms, vineyards, native flora and fauna with the Kumeu river originally providing a transport lifeline to the region.

The text "I am the True Vine" (John 15:1-8) was bought to life through a photo of two vinters harvesting grapes in the local area in the 1950's. "He who abides in Me and I in him bears much fruit; for without Me you can do nothing".

Central in the first window are images of God the Father, God the Son as Jesus the Lamb of God, and God the Holy Spirit, which are at the centre of our vision.

#### Role

Huapai Mission District is seeking a part-time Priest in Charge who is entitled to live and work in New Zealand.

The parish is easily able to support a  $\frac{1}{2}$  stipend, at this stage, and the appointee would be ably supported by the members, who are used to lay and ordained team ministry, and by our part time administrator.

The appointee would be a person who is a good team leader, is community focused, has development, communication and pastoral skills with visionary thinking.

Remuneration is according to the Anglican Diocese of Auckland Clergy Remuneration Guide, includes a housing allowance as well as covering Spiritual Direction, Supervision and Travel costs.

## History

Originally Huapai was part of the South Kaipara Anglican Methodist Parish/Cooperating Venture. In 2009 South Kaipara moved to Local Shared Ministry and we became Saint Chad's Huapai Anglican Methodist Local Shared Ministry Unit. In 2019 we decided to end our Co-operating venture and became Saint Chad's Huapai Anglican Church. The Local Shared Ministry model was a great model to resource and educate all the baptised and we thoroughly enjoyed this time. However, the model had run its course amongst us and we desired a fresh approach.

In October 2020, Diocesan Council gave approval to become a Mission District on the appointment of a Priest in Charge.

During the last 2 and a half years we have grown the congregation and started a Kid's Zone which meets during the service every Sunday morning. We also run home groups and a Christian Meditation group.
